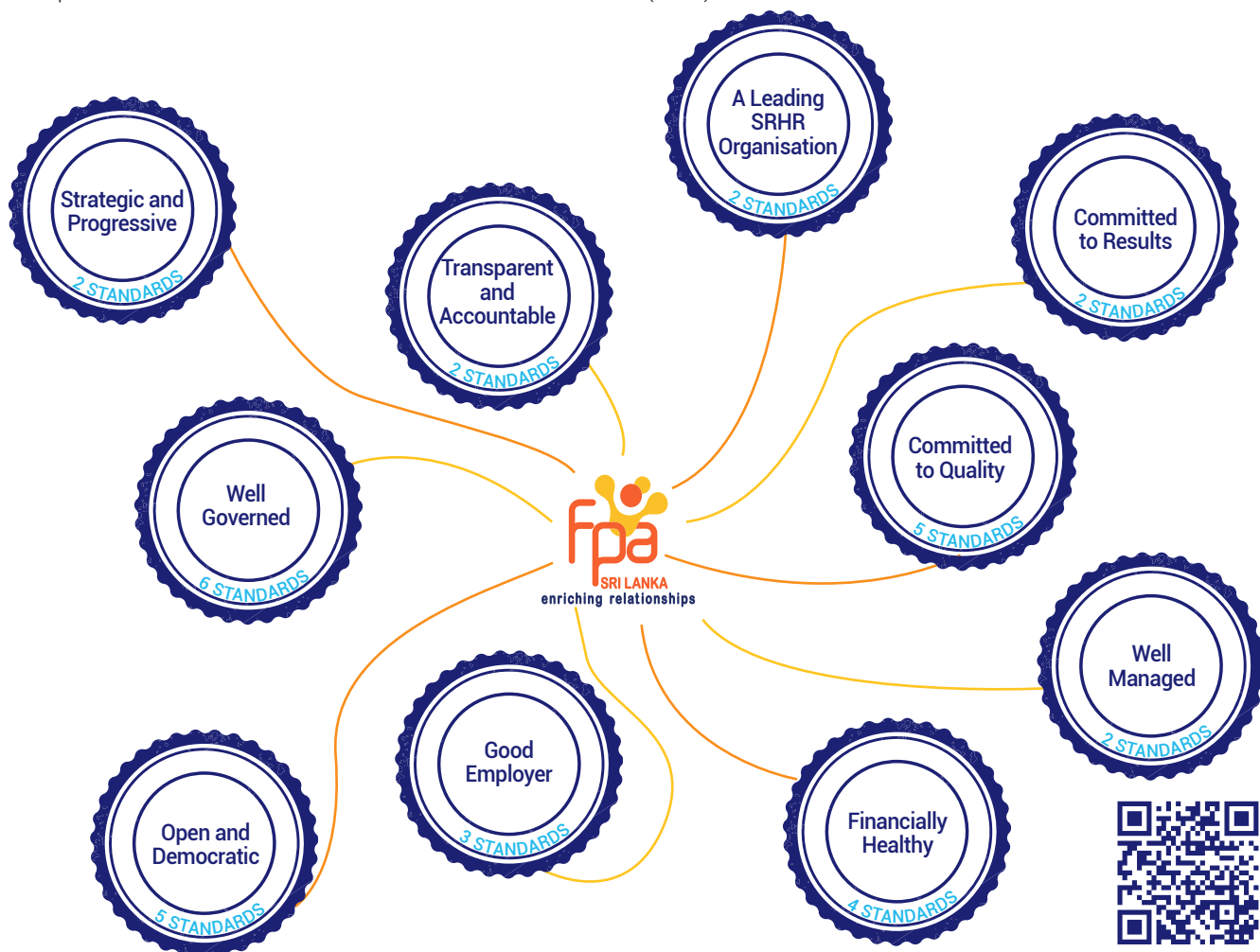

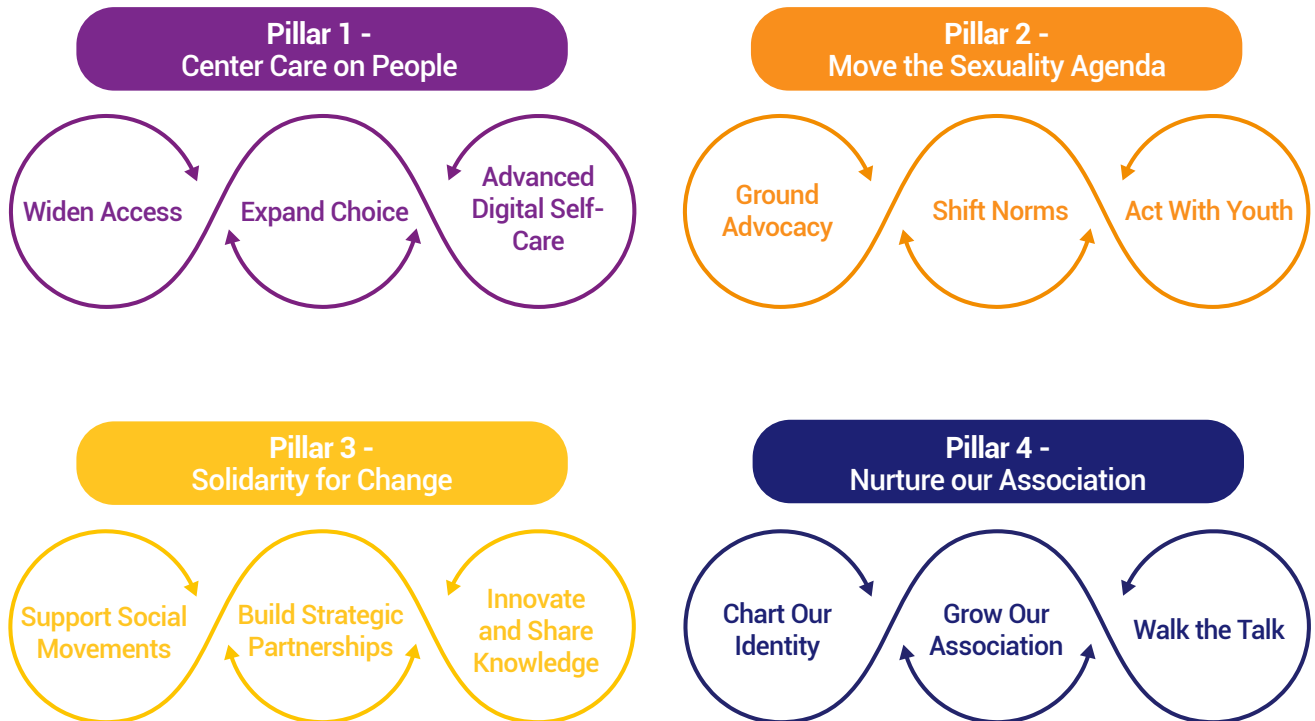

FPA's first clinic set-up at De Soysa Maternity Hospital.

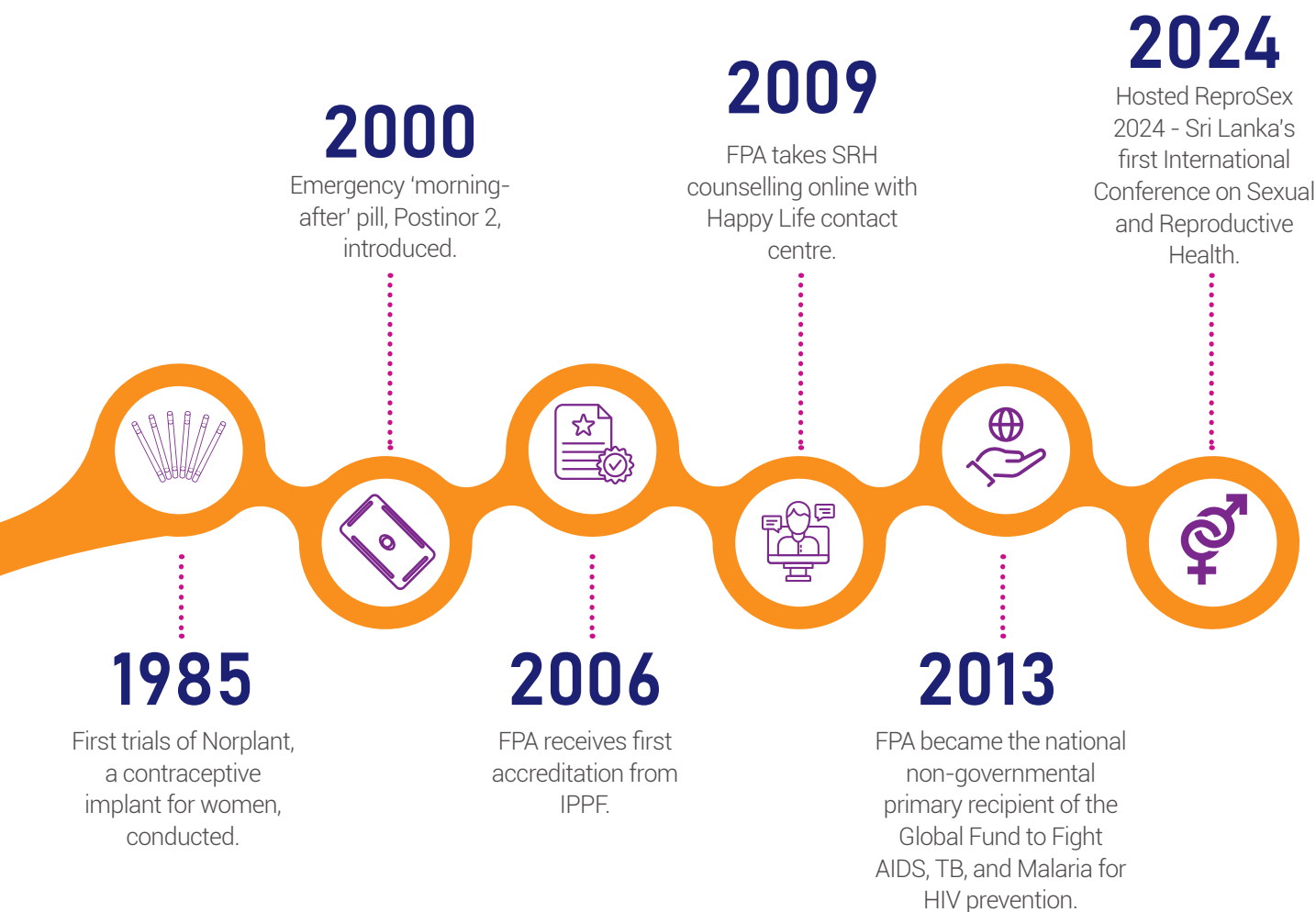
1961

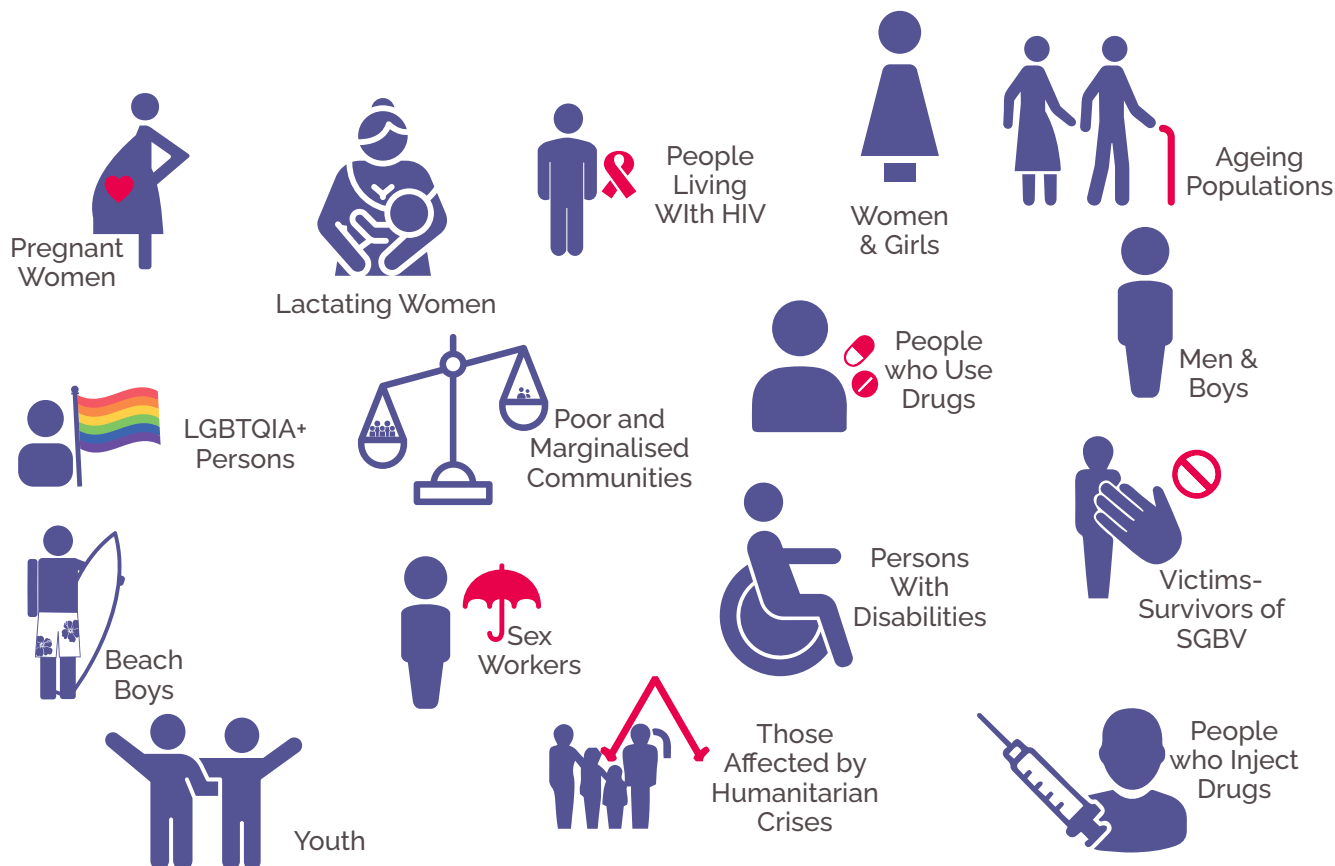
